1. Incident Name: Where's WALDO	2. Date: September 19, 2009	3. Time: 07:30:00 AM
4. Major Hazards and Risks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Players should dress appropriately to weather information and forecasts pursuant to regional Northern Virginia/Metro DC September timeframe. Remember that this area can and does have upwards of a 40° temperature change in one day. B. Players should provide food and beverages for themselves, especially if they are going to be deploying to the field. C. Abide by all site safety and security regulations. D. If there is a Real World Emergency, contact Net Control and the PWC EOC and use the phrase "Real World Emergency". Exercise play will be suspended until the emergency is resolved. E. If the Exercise needs to be cancelled due to a real activation, an "Emergency Exercise Cancellation" message will be transmitted. 		
5. Narrative: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. If site personnel ask you to move/relocate, acknowledge their request and relocate. Log the person's name, title and reason why you were asked to move. Do not confront them; it will be resolved on the backend after the exercise. B. Present a good image to the served agency. Remember we "work" for them, not the other way around.
